## Questions to ask my university disability coordinator

1)	Will I get priority or early registration for classes?
2)	What kind of interpreters are available, sign, oral, cued speech interpreters?
3)	Who makes arrangements for interpreters?
4)	What other services and/or programs are available in the community for someone with a hearing loss?
5)	Would I get academic and career counseling here in your office or from the general counseling offices on campus?
6)	Are interpreters available for out of class activities?
7)	How ae they paid?
8)	Is there a relay system (text or video) available on campus and in the residence halls?
9)	Are there assistive listening devices available for my use in the classroom?
10)	Is CART (computer assisted real time captioning) or notetakers available and how are they recruited?
11)	Who does the scheduling and arrangements for CART or notetakers in my class?
